Day 1 Detailed Itinerary for Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour Overfly

5:30 AM – 6:30 AM: Hotel Pickup & Transfer to Domestic Airport Terminal

Your Everest Base Camp Helicopter Overfly adventure begins with a scheduled pickup from your hotel in Kathmandu. A private vehicle will transfer you to the domestic terminal of Tribhuvan International Airport, where our dedicated team will assist you with check-in, luggage handling, and boarding procedures. The peaceful early morning drive through Kathmandu offers a comfortable start to an unforgettable Himalayan journey. Please ensure you carry your passport or valid identification along with your booking confirmation for airport verification.

6:30 AM – 7:00 AM: Flight Check-in & Safety Briefing

Upon arrival at the airport, our ground staff will guide you through the boarding process before introducing you to your experienced pilot. A comprehensive safety briefing covers helicopter procedures, flight routes, weather conditions, altitude awareness, and emergency protocols. Once final operational checks are completed, you'll be ready for takeoff toward the world's highest mountain.

7:00 AM – 7:45 AM: Helicopter Flight from Kathmandu (1,400m) to Lukla (2,845m)

Your helicopter departs Kathmandu and heads northeast toward the Everest region. As you leave the Kathmandu Valley behind, breathtaking views of lush green hills, terraced farmlands, winding rivers, and traditional mountain villages unfold beneath you. The landscape gradually transforms into rugged Himalayan terrain as snow-capped peaks begin to dominate the horizon. After approximately 40–45 minutes, the helicopter lands at Lukla Airport (2,845m), the famous gateway to the Everest region.

7:45 AM – 8:00 AM: Refueling Stop at Lukla Airstrip

The helicopter pauses briefly at Lukla Airport for refueling and final flight preparations. During this short stop, passengers may step outside to enjoy the crisp mountain air and admire the bustling atmosphere of one of the world's most iconic mountain airports. This break also allows the crew to complete operational checks before continuing deeper into the Khumbu region.

8:00 AM – 8:40 AM: Scenic Flight over Namche Bazaar, Tengboche, Dingboche, Lobuche & Gorakshep

After departing Lukla, the helicopter follows the legendary Everest Base Camp trekking route from above. Fly over the vibrant Sherpa town of Namche Bazaar, the spiritual surroundings of Tengboche Monastery, the alpine settlements of Dingboche and Lobuche, and finally the rugged landscape of Gorakshep. Throughout the flight, enjoy spectacular aerial views of deep valleys, suspension bridges, glaciers, ancient monasteries, and towering Himalayan peaks. This unique perspective showcases the complete Everest trekking route without the physical demands of trekking.

8:40 AM – 8:55 AM: Everest Base Camp & Kala Patthar Overfly (5,364m–5,545m)

Experience the highlight of the journey as the helicopter performs a spectacular overflight above Everest Base Camp and Kala Patthar. Witness the dramatic Khumbu Glacier, the legendary Khumbu Icefall, colorful expedition camps during climbing season, and unmatched close-up views of Mount Everest, Lhotse, Nuptse, Pumori, and surrounding Himalayan giants. Without landing at high altitude, you'll enjoy

approximately 10–15 minutes of unforgettable aerial sightseeing while the pilot circles the most iconic viewpoints for exceptional photography.

8:55 AM – 9:10 AM: Flight to Hotel Everest View (3,880m)

Leaving the high-altitude glaciers behind, the helicopter descends toward the world-famous Hotel Everest View. The short scenic flight offers magnificent panoramas of the Khumbu Valley, traditional Sherpa villages, alpine forests, and snow-covered mountain ridges before landing at one of the most scenic hotels in the Himalayas.

9:10 AM – 9:50 AM: Breakfast at Hotel Everest View

Enjoy a memorable breakfast or refreshments at the renowned Hotel Everest View (3,880m), celebrated as one of the world's highest luxury hotels. Relax with a warm meal while taking in uninterrupted panoramic views of Mount Everest, Ama Dablam, Lhotse, Thamserku, and surrounding Himalayan peaks. The peaceful setting, fresh mountain air, and extraordinary scenery create one of the most memorable moments of the entire helicopter tour.

9:50 AM – 10:00 AM: Return Flight to Lukla for Refueling

Following breakfast, the helicopter returns to Lukla for a brief refueling stop. During the flight, enjoy one final aerial perspective of the Khumbu Valley, picturesque Sherpa settlements, and rugged mountain landscapes before beginning the journey back to Kathmandu.

10:00 AM – 11:00 AM: Helicopter Flight Back to Kathmandu & Hotel Transfer

The final leg of your adventure takes you back to Kathmandu, retracing the scenic Himalayan route across alpine forests, terraced hillsides, winding rivers, and charming mountain villages. Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our representative will transfer you comfortably back to your hotel. Your Everest Base Camp Helicopter Overfly Tour concludes with unforgettable memories of one of the world's most spectacular aerial adventures through the heart of the Himalayas.
