Day 1 Everest Base Camp & Kala Patthar Landing Helicopter Tour Itinerary

- **Time** : 5-6 hours
- **Max Altitude** : 5545m

Accommodation: Hotel / Teahouse

05:30 AM – Hotel Pickup & Transfer to Kathmandu Domestic Airport

Your day starts with a pickup from your Kathmandu hotel by our team, followed by a hassle-free transfer to the domestic terminal at Tribhuvan International Airport. Our staff handles check-in and boarding, and after a quick safety briefing, you will meet your pilot and head for the majestic mountains.

06:00 AM – Airport Check-in & Flight Preparation

Before takeoff, you'll finish boarding formalities while your pilot guides you through the route, the day's weather, and key safety requirements. Once that's done, it's time to set up your board, get settled, and get your camera ready for the breathtaking views.

06:30 AM – Scenic Flight from Kathmandu to Lukla (2,860 m)

As the helicopter takes off out of Kathmandu, the scenery shifts fast; green hills and rivers give way to steep valleys and snow-capped peaks. It's one photo opportunity after another the whole way to Lukla.

07:20 AM – Technical Stop at Lukla Airport (2,860 m)

A short stop at Lukla, often called the **gateway to Everest**, gives the crew time for refueling or routine checks. It's also a good chance to snap a few photos at one of the most famous and most talked-about airports in the world.

07:35 AM – Scenic Flight from Lukla to Pheriche (4,371 m)

From Lukla, you'll fly deeper into the Khumbu Valley, passing over well-known Sherpa settlements like Namche Bazaar, Tengboche, Pangboche, and Dingboche.

Monasteries, alpine forest, glacial rivers, and towering peaks fill the view the entire way.

08:00 AM – Shuttle Flight Toward Kala Patthar

Due to the challenges of the extreme altitude, passengers may be split into smaller groups for the final ascent to Kala Patthar. This stretch takes you directly over Everest Base Camp, the Khumbu Glacier, and the Khumbu Icefall, views very few people ever get to see.

08:15 AM – Landing at Kala Patthar (5,545 m)

This is the moment the whole trip is toward. Step out at Kala Patthar and take in Everest, Lhotse, Nuptse, Ama Dablam, and the rest of the Himalayan giants around you. You'll have about 10–15 minutes here for photos and to simply take it all in before returning to the helicopter.

08:30 AM – Everest Base Camp Flyover

Leaving Kala Patthar, enjoy a flyover of Everest Base Camp and the Khumbu Glacier; the trekking route, expedition camps (during climbing season), and the Khumbu Icefall are all visible from above. It's a perspective on the region's scale that's hard to fully grasp from the ground.

08:45 AM – Breakfast at Hotel Everest View (3,880 m)

Next stop: Hotel Everest View, one of the **world's most unique, iconic, and exclusive mountain hotels**, where the luxury comes from the extraordinary location and once-in-a-lifetime Himalayan experience rather than lavish facilities. Sit down for breakfast with Everest in full view, relax on the terrace, and take a few more photos before it's time to head back.

09:30 AM – Return Flight to Lukla



After breakfast, you head back into the helicopter for the return flight that takes you through the Khumbu region once more over glaciers, alpine valleys, and the scattered rooftops of Sherpa villages, a last chance to soak in the mountain scenery and grab a few more shots before landing in Lukla.

10:00 AM – Brief Stop at Lukla (If Required)

Depending on weather and operational needs, there may be a short stopover in Lukla for refueling or a final check of the aircraft. This pause is simply part of ensuring everything runs safely and smoothly on the way back to Kathmandu.

10:15 AM – Scenic Flight from Lukla to Kathmandu

Settle in for the final stretch of the journey. Watching the towering peaks slowly fade into green hills, rivers, and farmland gives you a quiet moment to take in everything you've just experienced in the mountains.

11:05 AM – Arrival at Kathmandu Domestic Airport

Your helicopter lands safely back in Kathmandu, bringing an incredible morning in the Everest region to a close. Our team will greet you and assist you upon arrival, giving you a moment to let it all sink in: the flight above the Himalayas, Everest up close, and an unforgettable experience day.

11:30 AM – Hotel Drop-Off & Tour Ends

From the airport, our team will take you back to your hotel. This marks the end of your **Everest Base Camp & Kala Patthar Landing Helicopter Tour**, a morning spent above the world's highest mountains, standing at Kala Patthar, flying to Everest Base Camp, and having breakfast with the Himalayas as your backdrop. Cost Include

- Private helicopter flight from Kathmandu to the Everest region and return as per the scheduled itinerary.
- Exclusive scenic overflight of Everest Base Camp (5,364 m) and Kala Patthar (5,545 m) with breathtaking aerial views of Mount Everest and surrounding Himalayan peaks.
- Experienced CAAN-certified helicopter pilot and professional crew for safe mountain operations.
- Helicopter fuel charges, landing fees, and operational costs required for the Everest helicopter flight.

- Hotel Everest View landing stop with time for breakfast or refreshments while enjoying panoramic views of Mount Everest.
- Airport transfers in Kathmandu (hotel pickup and drop-off service as per package arrangement).
- Lukla technical stop and necessary flight arrangements during the journey.
- Passenger insurance as per Nepal aviation regulations.
- Oxygen cylinder and first-aid kit available on board for passenger safety during high-altitude flight.
- All applicable government taxes, airport charges, and service fees.
